Case histories

Case 1

79 year old female
2 weeks of painful red plaques left leg
Recent diagnosis of NHL.

Case 2

61 year old female
Flat topped violaceous papules with some coalescence involving wrists, arms, buttocks and thighs.

Case 3

50 year old male
Morbilliform eruption on trunk and palmar hands.

Case 4

35 year old male
Enlarging plaque on shoulder.

Case 5

61 year old female.
Widespread discoid plaques on body.

Case 6

80 year old female
Infiltrated nodules on left arm developing over 3 months.

Case 7

60 year old female
Pruritic vulval plaque.

Case 8

45 year old male
Blistering erosions on trunk and upper arms with oral involvement.

Case 9

58 year old male

Psoriasiform eruption and palmar keratoderma.

Case 10

65 year old male

Painful ulcerated lesions on digits.

Case 11

13 year old female

Yellowish plaque on abdomen

Family history of neurofibromatosis.

Case 12

63 year old female

Blistering eruption over lower limbs

Severe Rheumatoid Arthritis

No new medications.

Case 13

53 year old female

Circular lesions over right inner thigh.

Case 14

25 year old female

Slowly growing indurated lesion over shoulder.

Case 15

21 year old female

Unusual rippled appearance on neck over 4 years.
