

### Case histories for Adelaide small biopsy course GIT presentation

1. Female 73 – Abdominal pain; sheets of white mucosa in oesophagus
2. Male 75 – 4cm segment of Barrett's oesophagus
3. Female 55 – EMR of oesophageal nodule
4. Female 55 – Anaemia for investigation; normal stomach biopsied
5. Male 44 – Dysphagia and epigastric pain; raised erosions in stomach
6. Female 86 – Haematemesis; gastric polyp seen
7. Male 65 – Recent distal pancreatectomy for pancreatic ductal carcinoma; erosion at duodenal papilla
8. Female 60 – Diarrhoea; normal colon
9. Female 72 – Abdominal pain; red patch at splenic flexure
10. Female 42 – Iron deficiency anaemia; 4cm flat lesion in rectum
11. Male 81 – Anaemia for investigation; 1cm rectal polyp
12. Male 66 – FOBT positive; 2cm sigmoid polyp
13. Female 81 – Caecal polypectomy
14. Female 66 – Abdominal fullness; 4mm sigmoid polyp
15. Male 70 – Iron deficiency; EMR of polyp at anal verge
