

RCPA EXAMINATIONS - 2022

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

The closing date for 2022 examination applications is:

5.00 PM SYDNEY TIME: FRIDAY 18 FEBRUARY 2022

Applications accompanied by the correct examination fee must be submitted directly to the College by post or in person. Please ensure that you keep a copy for your own reference.

Faxed or emailed applications will not be accepted.

You will receive email acknowledgement of your application after initial processing.

Late applications: Any applications which arrive at the College after the closing date of **18 February 2022** will attract an additional fee as outlined in the 2022 RCPA Schedule of Fees. No examination application will be accepted after **4 March 2022**. Please note the relevant penalties for withdrawal from examinations which appear on the fee schedule.

You must advise the College where you intend to sit the May (Phase 1) examinations. See list below.

- Australia: Adelaide, Brisbane, Canberra, Darwin, Hobart, Melbourne, Perth or Sydney
- New Zealand: Auckland, Christchurch, Dunedin, and Wellington
- Hong Kong, Malaysia (Kuala Lumpur), Saudi Arabia (Riyadh), and Singapore

Phase 2 examinations are held in pre-designated centres

Details of venues and the start times of examinations will be available following release of Phase 1 results.

Following the processing of all applications, candidates will receive an email which will include a link to the College website where the details of the examination/s in which they are enrolled can be accessed. The information will confirm enrolment in each component and give precise details of the time and venue of the examination/s. It will also include the contact details of the local invigilator. The email is confirmation of your enrolment in the examination. **Please check your personal details on the College website (link below) and update your email address if needed.**
