

Examination Fee changes from 2022

In 2020 and 2021, in response to COVID-19, the College experienced significant additional costs related to the facilitation of examinations in local jurisdictions and oral and digital slide examinations in a virtual digital setting. These methods attracted increased venue and other required technology related costs, including robust testing to help ensure effective facilitation of the exams.

Following the 2021 August examination round, the Board revisited how exams are to be held from 2022. Decisions considered the continuing uncertainty pertaining to the COVID pandemic, feedback received from Trainees, Chief Examiners, Examiners and other stakeholders, and the success of exam facilitation for the past two years.

The RCPA is committed to offering quality training and assessment and the Board therefore determined that examinations from 2022 will continue to be facilitated in local jurisdictions and where appropriate, in a virtual digital setting. As such, examination fees will increase from 2022 to support changes to the format and delivery of college examinations.
