The College has three Faculties: the Faculty of Oral and Maxillo-facial Pathology; the Faculty of Science; and, the Faculty of Clinical Forensic Medicine. This Policy outlines the approved post-nominals for Fellows and members of the Faculties.

Although initially named the Faculty of Oral Pathology (with the post-nominal FFOP), the descriptor 'Maxillofacial' was added in 2011. Thus **FFOMP (RCPA)** is currently appropriate for use by Fellows of the Faculty who are not also Fellows of the College and **FFOMP** is appropriate for those who are also Fellows of the College. Forensic Odontologists recently joined the Faculty and their post nominal is FFOMP (Forensic Odontology) (RCPA).

For Fellows of the Faculty of Science, **FFSc (RCPA)** is appropriate for use by Fellows of the Faculty who are not also Fellows of the College and **FFSc** is appropriate for those who are also Fellows of the College. A pathway via Research has since become available and the post nominal for this group is **FFSc (Research) (RCPA)**.

For Fellows of the Faculty of Clinical Forensic Medicine, it is appropriate for Fellows of the Faculty to use **FFCFM (RCPA)** and that **FFCFM** is appropriate for those who are also Fellows of the College. Associates of the Faculty may use **AFCFM (RCPA)**.
