The closing date for 2020 examination applications is:

5.00 PM SYDNEY TIME: FRIDAY 21 FEBRUARY 2020

Applications, accompanied by the correct examination fee, must be submitted directly to the College by post or in person. Please ensure that you keep a copy for your own reference. Faxed or emailed applications will not be accepted.

For Medical School students, i.e. those undertaking their primary degree, proof of your current registration with your University must be included. The College only accepts a letter from your University confirming your status, the date of your enrolment and an expected course completion date. Your application will not be processed without this letter.

Late applications any applications which arrive at the College after the closing date of 21-February 2020 will attract an additional fee equal to 50% of the relevant examination fee. Remission of this fee will only be granted under exceptional circumstances. No examination application will be accepted after 6 March 2020. Please note the relevant penalties for withdrawal from examinations which appear on the fee schedule.

You will receive email acknowledgement after your application has been processed.

You must advise the College where you intend to sit the examination.

Venues are as follows:

- Australia: Adelaide, Brisbane, Canberra, Darwin, Hobart, Melbourne, Perth or Sydney
- New Zealand: Auckland, Christchurch, Dunedin and Wellington
- Hong Kong, Malaysia (Kuala Lumpur), Saudi Arabia (Riyadh), and Singapore
