Purpose

To support medical, science and dental students and early post graduate year doctors in broadening and enhancing their training experience with an understanding of the role of pathology by providing them with access to the RCPA NZ Annual Scientific Meeting which covers the scientific discipline of Anatomical Pathology and on occasion other disciplines and areas of interest.

Applicant eligibility

Open to all medical, science and dental students and early post graduate year doctors in New Zealand.

Grant offer

There are eight (8) complimentary registrations to attend the RCPANZ ASM available annually for Medical, Science and Dental Students and early post graduate year doctors. Registration includes meals and social events at the ASM but does not include any flights/accommodation/incidentals.

Additional Grants - Aboriginal, Maori and/or Torres Strait Islanders

The College will fund up to two (2) medical, science and dental students that identify as Aboriginal, Maori and/or Torres Strait Islander to attend the RCPANZ ASM. These grants will cover the registration, return economy class flights within New Zealand, airport transfers (taxi/uber), accommodation plus breakfast for 3-4 nights (depending on where the applicant lives) and all meals on offer at the ASM. No incidentals are covered.

Application Process

Completion and submission of a form by the due date. The form is updated annually and can be accessed on the College website under the RCPANZ ASM tab.

Application Assessment Process

All applications are reviewed by the RCPA NZ Committee and awarded at their discretion.

Notification

Applicants will be advised in writing of the outcome of their applications by the date specified on the application form and must respond to confirm their acceptance of the grant.

Please note:

This is a separate grant for New Zealand and should not be confused with the RCPA Pathology Update Grant for medical, science and dental students or the RCPA Scholarships in Pathology program for medical, dental and science students which are also run by the College.
