The College will not accept unprofessional or unethical behaviour in candidates for Fellowship.

- Candidates found to be cheating in an examination will have that examination recorded as a Fail.
- Where a candidate is found to have given information during the examination period regarding the content of the examination to any other candidate that examination will be recorded as a Fail for both candidates.
- Candidates found to have plagiarised content in casebooks, projects, dissertations or other written assessments, will have that assessment recorded as a Fail.
- The Board of Education and Assessment will bring these matters to the attention of the Board of Directors for appropriate action.
- Appeals against issues of Plagiarism and Cheating in Examinations will be dealt with using "Regulations", Regulations Governing Review Process for Review of Decisions of Committees of the College Board.
