Ward Cover:

- Average 15 – 20 inpatients at any one time with various malignant and non-malignant disorders for diagnosis and treatment.
- Patient undergoing chemotherapy, autologous transplant and treatment for various non-malignant haematological disorders.

Chemotherapy day unit:

- Ambulatory care for patients undergoing chemotherapy / other treatments for various haematological disorders.

Consultative haematology:

- Both out-patient, accident and emergency and inpatient consultations on a wide range of malignant, haemostasis / thrombosis and other non-malignant problems.

Thursday outpatients:

- Malignant and non-malignant general haematology new and follow-up patients including those on clinical trials.

Tuesday outpatients:

- Malignant (esp. myeloma) and non-malignant haematology conditions and clinical trial patients.

Educational meetings:

- weekly journal club and inpatient review session,
- weekly alternating Radiology review meeting and Lymphoma MDM session,
- weekly BM morphology review,
- weekly Grand Round,
- weekly Department of Medicine clinical presentations,
- monthly Interhospital Haematology meetings,
- monthly slide morphology meetings.

Audit/projects:

- Each registrar allocated at least 1 SVHM project in the training year for completion / presentation / publication.

Research and Publications:

- Each registrar is expected to be involved in at least 1 research project that results in either abstract submission to local or national haematology meetings or publication during their stay at SVHM.
