The Award

The Eva Raik Haematology Trainee Prize is for the RCPA candidate who receives the highest aggregate mark for the Part I and Part II Haematology examination for admittance as a Fellow of the RCPA (or any examination which supersedes or replaces the above).

Value and Payment

The value of the prize will be \$5,000 and is to be indexed annually against CPI. The winner is to be presented at the annual RCPA Admission of New Fellows and Awards Ceremony.

Administration

The prize is to be controlled, managed and administered by the RCPA Foundation which has delegated selection of prize winners to the Board of Education and Assessment which conducts the haematology examinations and judges the outcomes. The Chief Examiner for Haematology on the Board of Education and Assessment will decide the winning candidate based on examination performance.

History

The Eva Raik Haematology Trainee Prize was established by the late Dr Eva Raik OAM via a generous bequest in her will. Dr Raik was active in College life over many years, serving on numerous committees as a member and a Chair and held positions on the then College Council in 1980s and 1990s, including as President of the College. A distinguished haematologist who was associated with many external organisations she was responsible for bringing the Kanematsu Award into the College and was instrumental in establishing NATA/RCPA accreditation.
