

Pathology Update

Speaker Abstract Requirements

1. Abstracts must be submitted via email in an attached Word document.
2. Abstracts must not exceed 200 words (excluding title, authors and institution).
3. The title should be brief and explicit.
4. Underline the submitting/presenting author, use superscript numerals for author affiliations, and italicise the list of affiliations, e.g.
Harold Cook¹, Paul Stephens¹, Kate J. Davies¹, Garry Harding², Don W. Thomas¹
¹Department of Oral Surgery, Royal North Shore Hospital, Sydney, Australia; ²Wound Healing Research Unit, Department of Surgery, University of Wales, Cardiff, UK
5. If providing a structured abstract, headings should be bold followed by a colon, e.g.
Background: This study was conducted because...
Methods: The method used for this study.....
6. There is a maximum of three references.
7. Figures and tables will not be published.
8. Abbreviations should be only used for common terms. For uncommon terms, the abbreviation should be given in brackets after the first full use of the word.
9. Abstracts must be submitted by the deadline to be included in the Pathology Update abstract supplement of the RCPA journal Pathology, published by Elsevier.
